



BRITISH COLUMBIA Livestock Tag Reader Rebate







Program Information

ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS:

- B.C. livestock operators (e.g. ranchers, abattoirs and 4-H districts).
- Applicants must own, sell, feed, house, or care for cattle, hogs, sheep, bison, cervids, and/or goats in B.C.
- Materials, equipment, and/or services must be directly related to the facilitation of livestock traceability activities.
- Applicants must be registered in the BC Premises Identification Program (BCPID).
 - Registration for BCPID can happen simultaneously with this application: <u>www.gov.bc.ca/premisesidprogram</u>
 - 4-H district applicants can provide the BCPID# for the location where they showcase their animals, i.e. agricultural fair grounds or 4-H leader's farm.

FUNDING:

- 70% of the cost to a maximum rebate of \$3,500 per applicant for all eligible items combined.
- Funding received previously under *Growing Forward* Enterprise Infrastructure Technologies Program and *Growing Forward* 2 Traceability Adoption, On Farm Food Safety and Traceability, and Post Farm Food Safety and Traceability Programs will not be attributed to the maximum rebate amount.
- Approval of funding to applicants is subject to the overall demand and availability of funds.
- Funding is available on a first-come, first-served basis and may be altered or discontinued without notice. The program ends January 31, 2023.

ELIGIBLE ITEMS:

- Rebates may be provided for livestock tag readers (hand-held or panel readers), reader installation, related software, and related equipment training.
- Readers must be utilized for livestock traceability purposes to be eligible.
- Readers must be listed on the Canadian Cattle Identification Agency's (CCIA) Conditionally Verified Readers list: <u>https://www.canadaid.ca/wp-content/uploads/2021/11/CCIA-Reader-List-November-</u>2021.pdf
- Software may have a broad range of abilities such as herd management capabilities but must have traceability capability. Software must be used in conjunction with a reader to be eligible for rebate.
- For standalone software to be eligible for rebate, applicant must already have a tag reader in place (with proof of purchase) and provide confirmation from either software or tag reader company that the two are compatible. Standalone software must also have the capability to report livestock traceability data to the tag administrator (e.g. CCIA).
- Participants are encouraged to request and receive training on how to use the livestock tag reader equipment. Training must be provided by equipment providers and be related to the implementation of traceability equipment and technologies.
- Training without purchasing livestock tag reader equipment is ineligible for rebate.
- Equipment, materials, and services must be purchased between November 2018 and January 31, 2023.
- Ineligible items include, but are not limited to: taxes, computers, ear tags, load bars, and livestock handling systems.
